Order

WHEREAS, the institution, namely, NANI-BAI COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, AMRAVATI, MAHARASHTRA was granted conditional recognition by WRC, NCTE for B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 60 vide order No.WRC/5-6/20/99/2889-91 dated 10.05.2000 upto the academic session 2000-2001 followed by letter dated 18.05.2004 regarding revision/refixation in B.Ed. intake from 60 to 100 from the academic session 2004-2005.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution, namely, NANI-BAI COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, SAMTA COLONY, KATHORA ROAD, AMRAVATI-444604, MAHARASHTRA was granted formal recognition by WRC, NCTE for B.Ed. course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 vide order No.WRC/5-6/59/2004/6133-138 dated 17.09.2004 from the academic session 2004-2005.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the revised recognition order was issued to the institution vide order No.WRC/OAPW0493/113061/2015/136691, 692, 693, 694,695,696,698,700 dated 25.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-2016.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order was placed in the 255th WRC meeting held on June 22-24, 2016 and the Committee decided that show cause notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance. Accordingly, show cause notice issued to the institution dated 31.03.2017.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, in response to the aforesaid show cause notice, reply submitted by the institution dated 23.10.2017.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by WRC in its 281st meeting held on September 19-20, 2017 and the Committee observed as follows:-

"In order to systemetise the compilation of complete information of all TEPs in the country, the NCTE HQrs New Delhi had asked all institutions to submit the Mandatory Affidavit on the prescribed format. The first such Public Notice was issued on 05.10.2016. Further opportunity was given on 16.06.2017, and the last date for submission was 12.09.2017.

NCTE Delhi also issued Show Cause Notice through PUBLIC NOTICE to submit the Mandatory Affidavit within the specified date. Then, it compiled the list of institutions and identified TEIs which had not complied with the submission of Mandatory Affidavit. The lists were sent to the WRO to reconcile the discrepancies with regard to the address as well as duplication of entries for placing the list to WRC for initiating the process of de-recognition of such institutions. These lists were tabled during the meeting.

The WRC perused the lists as provided by the HQrs as well as the details provided by the WRO.

Thereafter, the WRC decided to issue Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of the NCTE Act for non-compliance of the directions of the NCTE, and why the institution should not be de-recognized. The reply should be sent on or before 23rd October 2017 after which further necessary action will be taken as per the Regulations."

Accordingly, show cause notice dated 23.09.2017 was issued to submit the Mandatory Affidavit on the prescribed format. No reply submitted by the institution.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, institution vide letter dated 24.11.2022, has requested for reduction of B.Ed. intake from 100 (two units) to 50 (one basic unit) alongwith the resolution of the society to this effect.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by WRC in its 376th meeting held on 29th November, 2022 and the Committee has decided the following:-

"The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents, were carefully examined in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- Initial recognition was granted for B.Ed. course of one year dated 18.05.2004 followed by formal recognition order dated 17.09.2004.
- Revised order was issued for B.Ed. course of two years dated 25.05.2015.
- Show cause notice dated 31.03.2017 was issued due to non-compliance of conditions as required under NCTE Regulations, 2014 followed by show cause notice u/s 17 dated 23.09.2017 in the matter of submission of mandatory affidavit. No reply submitted by the institution.
- The proposal submitted by institution vide letter dated 24.11.2022 for reduction of B.Ed. intake from 100 (two units) to 50 (one basic unit).

In view of the above, the Committee decided as under:


The institution be allowed permission for the reduction of B.Ed. intake from 100 (two units) to 50 (one basic unit) w.e.f. the commencement of academic session 2022-2023. The Affiliating Body/State Government and others be intimated accordingly.

Further, the institution be informed to submit compliance on the show cause notice dated 31.03.2017 and 23.09.2017 within 30 days accompanied by an original affidavit within 30 days from the date of uploading of minutes on the website failing which the WRC will take decision as deemed fit as per the provisions contained in the NCTE Act and Regulations."

9. **NOW THEREFORE**, permission is hereby granted to institution viz. NANI-BAI COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, SAMTA COLONY, KATHORA ROAD, AMRAVATI-444604, MAHARASHTRA reducing the annual intake of B.Ed. course from 100 (two units of 50 students each) to 50 (one basic unit of 50 students) w.e.f. the commencement of the academic session 2022-2023.

10. The terms and conditions shall remain same mentioned in the revised recognition order issued vide order dated 25.05.2015.


